During office hours, our Nurse Practitioners and Physicians are available by phone to answer any questions. After hours, through our answering service, you can seek

guidance and support from one of our on-call Physicians and/or a Registered Nurse (part of a nursing phone triage team that we have worked with for many years).

We are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for any concerns

Along with all aspects of routine and acute pediatric care, we offer behavioral and psychiatric treatment - provided by Rebecka Evans who has extensive experience treating behavioral and emotional issues. Rebecka is available in our office for patient consultation and ongoing management.

We have a full-service lab for blood draws and run rapid strep, flu, RSV tests and throat cultures in the office giving quick and accurate results. We repair small lacerations with Dermabond Surgical Repair Glue and can treat warts with liquid nitrogen.

We also provide the highest level of continuity of care and try to avoid the use of urgent care centers or the Emergency Room, unless necessary.

There is always a member of our team that you can call to discuss the appropriate level and location of service for your child.

You may use the Patient Portal (Mychart) to send messages directly to our providers and front desk staff - for care related and administrative questions - such as scheduling visits and requesting referrals.

We are on-staff at Boston Children's Hospital and Massachusetts General Hospital, working closely with the specialists at these outstanding facilities.

For urgent care, we utilize the Emergency Room services at these Boston Hospitals, along with excellent community hospitals in our area - including Winchester Hospital, Newton Wellesley Hospital and Emerson Hospital.
